





Claremont Wolves and AYSO United Claremont Volunteer Points Program

Region 3 is proud to offer a complete soccer development program, starting with Playground and Schoolyard for 3 and 4 year-olds. For players from 5 to 18, we offer Fall and Spring recreational leagues. We also have a growing Futsal program and opportunities for competitive play beginning in U10 in our Spring Select, Claremont Wolves Extra, and AYSO United Claremont club programs.

All these programs bring value to our soccer community, and they all require support from members of the community serving as volunteers. We especially need support for our Core program because it's the heart of Claremont AYSO. It's where all our players start and where the vast majority play.

Region 3 requires Wolves and United teams to support our Core, Futsal, and Wolves programs. Before approving a team, the coaches and families must commit to earning **50 Volunteer Points**. Wolves teams will also have to provide referees for other Wolves games when they play at home.

How do teams earn Volunteer Points?

- +25 Serve in an executive, trainer, or division coordinator role on the Region 3 Board
- +15 Serve in another role on the Region 3 Board
- +15 Advance your referee badge from Regional to Intermediate or higher
- +10 Coach a Core team
- +10 Serve on the Robot Painting Squad
- +5 Run an open skills clinic
- +5 Provide a Center Referee for a Core game (Core or Wolves for United teams)
- +2 Provide an Assistant Referee for a Core game (Core or Wolves for United teams)
- +2 Provide a referee for a Futsal session

Each season, the Regional Commissioner, Assistant Regional Commissioner, Coach Administrator, and Extra Coordinator will review participation for Wolves and United teams.

What happens if your team is awesome at volunteering?

- Region 3 will give a Pizza Party for the teams who earn the most Volunteer Points!
- The team with the most Volunteer Points will win the Community Shield trophy!

What happens if you don't accumulate 50 Volunteer Points?

- Coaches may lose eligibility to coach Wolves or United teams in Region 3
- United teams may lose the ability to practice and play home games in Region 3
- Wolves teams may lose the ability to participate in the AYSO Extra circuit
